2024 AYSO Merry Kickmas Allstar Tournament Team Invitation

AYSO Region 638 is proud to invite your team to the 1st Annual AYSO Quartz Hill Kickmas Allstar Tournament

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: Saturday and Sunday, December 14 and 15, 2024. No Rain Dates

Where: The tournament will be held at Joe Walker Middle School, Gregg Anderson Academy, and Marie Kerr Park.
No pets are allowed at the fields.

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: 14-U (11v11) 15 players max. 12-U (9v9) 12 players max. and 10-U (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2024 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (maximum 3 per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys divisions only.

What: Pool play tournament. ***Each team will be playing a guaranteed 3 games.*** The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday. All games will be as follows: (60 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12, and 40 min for U-10).

Why: The Merry Kickmas tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 638 to raise funds for Field and Player Development, Equipment, and Maintenance, and to provide Scholarship funds for youths in Region 638.

Awards: All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament pin. 1st and 2nd place will receive a medal.

Entry Fee, Refunds: \$650 for 14-U, \$600 for 12-U, and \$550 for 10-U. A full refund will be issued if the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.

Referee Fee Refunds: No Referee Deposit will be collected. However, each team is required to provide a qualified, 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is November 22, 2024. Once your online application is submitted and you receive a confirmation email you are considered accepted. Payment must be received within two weeks or some communication to the tournament director on why your payment will be late. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.

How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers the Entry fee, along with the tournament application, referee information form, and roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Your Regional commissioner must sign the application and Blue Sombrero roster. The appropriate referee administrator must sign the Referee Information Form. See referee form for details.
